BlueHPN is designed for **self-funded businesses** with employees living in the BlueHPN service area. This innovative solution allows your eligible members to have in-network-only access to high-quality care through a national network that offers total cost of care savings of 11% on average, compared to our industry leading PPO.

What makes Blue High Performance Network unique is that it is grounded by each Blue Plan's local market expertise, deep data and strong provider relationships. BlueHPN partners with each market's local providers, holding them accountable for improving care. In this way, BlueHPN is capable of delivering quality care at a lower cost. Performance data has shown that BlueHPN is 38% less likely to experience early elective deliveries and 36% less likely to experience readmission, compared to national industry benchmarks.*





In-Network-Only Access

BlueHPN is an Exclusive Provider Organization (EPO). This means benefits are only covered for care by in-network providers. Out-of-network services within the BlueHPN markets are covered for emergent care only. Out-of-network services outside the BlueHPN markets are covered for emergent and urgent care only.

How Does BlueHPN Fit With Other Network Options?

Self-funded groups with employees in one or more of BlueHPN's service areas should consider offering BlueHPN alongside a broader BlueCard PPO offering as a dual or triple option for their employees' choice. For all solutions offered, self-funded groups can customize plan designs to fit their needs.
